WHAT DOES POWERPAY DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number, income, and assets
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and credit scores
- Name, address, and employment information

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons PowerPay chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do		
How does PowerPay protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does PowerPay collect my information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Apply for an extension of credit Talk with a customer service representative Use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes —information about your creditworthiness saffiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
